Checker Board

Unfinished Wood Frame, 12x12

Acrylic Paint

Foam Brush

Galvanized Tin Tile, 12x12

Two Contrasting Papers

Clear Marbles (32 pcs)

Magnets, 3/4" (32 pcs)

Mod Podge

Directions

1. Cut your paper into 1.5 inch squares and glue onto the metal board in a checker board pattern with the Mod Podge.

2. Paint your unfinished wood frame. Let dry.

3. Insert the metal tile into the frame.

4. With your remaining paper cut circles out the same shape as your marbles. Use the Mod Podge to glue the paper onto the back of the marble. The Mod Podge will act as a glue and a sealer and will dry clear. Let dry completely.

5. Glue the magnets onto the backs of your marbles.

6. Set up your game and start playing!

Memory Game Clip Art (find images online)

Directions

1. Cut out your clip art game pieces and cut plain pieces of paper the same size as your game pieces.

2. Cut out foam core the same size as your game pieces. Cut out a hole in the middle of the foam core the same size as your magnet.

3. Glue a game piece onto one side of the foam core. Put a magnet in the hole and glue a loop of ribbon on the corner. Glue the plain paper on top. Repeat this process to make the other game tiles.


4. Paint the unfinished wood frame. Let dry.

5. Put the metal tile in the frame with the patterned paper on top.

6. Put your tiles on the board and play a game!

Optional: Make a title header for your board that says "Memory Game!"

Supplies

Unfinished Wood Frame, 12x12

Patterned Paper, 12x12

Galvanized Tin Tile, 12x12

Large Wood X's and O's

Craft Sticks

Acrylic Paint

Foam Brush

Magnets

Aleene's Tacky Glue

Hot Glue Gun & Glue Sticks

Directions

1. Paint your unfinished wood frame. Let dry.
2. Insert the tin tile into the frame with the patterned paper on top.
3. Glue the craft sticks on their side in a # shape.
4. Glue the magnets on the back of the X's and O's
5. Begin playing your game!
