## Tulle Wreath

### **Supplies**

- Styrofoam Wreath Form
- 2 Greening Push Pins
- 2 Rolls of Ribbon
- 4 Rolls of Tulle (solid and/or glitter)

#### **Directions**

- 1. Wrap  $1\frac{1}{2}$  rolls of ribbon snuggly around the wreath form, using a greening push pin to hold the beginning and end of the ribbon in place. This will hide the white of the wreath form with your choice of color.
- Cut a length of tulle (Approx. 18" pictured above longer for a more feathered effect),
   Fold the length of Tulle in half and wrap around the wreath form, pulling
   ends through the loop until snug, then knot if desired. Repeat this step
   until wreath is full. Intersperse colors, or solid and glitter tulle, to create a
   desired look.
- 3. Embellish as desired (Pictured Above Foam ghost with glitter; glitter applied with glow-in-the-dark Modge Podge; attached foam eyes).
- 4. Using the the remaining ribbon create a loop and bow to hang the new wreath on a wall or door.



# Tulle Wreath

### **Supplies**

- Styrofoam Wreath Form
- 2 Greening Push Pins
- 2 Rolls of Ribbon

#### **Directions**

- Wrap 1½ rolls of ribbon snuggly around the wreath form, using a
  greening push pin to hold the beginning and end of the ribbon in place.
  This will hide the white of the wreath form with your choice of color.
- 2. Cut a length of tulle (Approx. 18" pictured above longer for a more feathered effect), Fold the length of Tulle in half and wrap around the wreath form, pulling ends through the loop until snug, then knot if desired. Repeat this step until wreath is full. Intersperse colors, or solid and glitter tulle, to create a desired look.
- 3. Embellish as desired (Pictured Above Foam ghost with glitter; glitter applied with glow-in-the-dark Modge Podge; attached foam eyes).
- 4. Using the the remaining ribbon create a loop and bow to hang the new wreath on a wall or door.
