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The 15 Minute Table Runner... No Really!

Supplies

- 1/2 yard Fabric
- 1/3 yard Fabric

Directions

- Open up the two pieces of fabric and put them right side together. Sew
 the two side to each other, using ¼" seam allowance, creating a tube.
 Turn the tube right side out. Press so as equal amounts of fabric are on
 each side of the center fabric.
- 2. At one end of the tube, fold the tube back to back stitch across the end. Fold it to the other side, creating a point. Repeat on other side.
- 3. To hold down the tow end pieces there are several options. The easist way is to add a button to each side of the table runner at the center seam. Rick rack or a pretty ribbon can also be used or, add tassels to the pointed ends.

Additional Ideas: Create the tube as explained in step 1, cut it in half creating two equal parts. Finish as if each is a full runner. This creates two darling placemats!



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
