



Fast & Fun Hot Pad

Supplies

- 5 - 10½" Squares of Fabric
(3 of 1 color and 2 of another)
- 2 - 10½" Squares of Cotton Batting
or Insul-Bright®
- Matching Thread

Directions

1. Lay down squares of cotton batting, or Insul-Bright®, on top of another.
2. Next, lay down one square of fabric right side up.
3. Fold the remaining fabric squares in half, wrong sides together and press.
4. Layer together on top of the previous square that was right side up.
Folded edges to the center, weaving one end under and the other end over the pieces adjacent to it. Similar to folding a box closed without tape.
5. Sew through all layers using a ½" seam allowance on all 4 sides.
6. Trim seam allowances and corners. Turn inside out and press.
7. Secure in the center by sewing a square to hold down the folded edges if desired. To make an 8" Hot Pad simply use a ¼" seam allowance.



Fast & Fun Hot Pad
