



# Canvas Crayon Art

## Supplies

- 9" x 12" Artist Canvas
- Box 24 count crayons
- E-6000 glue
- Heat gun tool

## Directions:

1. Glue crayons along top of canvas with E-6000 glue
2. Let set for 24 hours
3. Turn on Heat Gun and focus the heat on the bottom half of the crayons.  
Melt only until you have the look you want
4. Leave the top half of the crayon unmelted
5. Heating the crayons too long will melt the crayons completely and you will only have the paper wrappers left

Add a vinyl word/embellishment to the bottom of the canvas

If adding a vinyl word, spray a sealer to the area to place your letters. The vinyl does not stick directly to the unsealed canvas.
