



# Hooded Textured Baby Blanket

## Supplies

- Pound of Yarn in desired color
- Crochet Hook - Size J-10
- Large-eye Blunt Needles

### Blanket

1. Ch 108
2. Beg with Row 1, work in Textured St until piece measures 28 in. (72 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

### Hood

1. Beg in top corner of Hood, ch 4

**Row 1:** Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, 2 dc in frost st, dc in next st, 3 dc in top of turning ch - 7 dc (including turning ch) at end of row

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, dc in first st, dc in each st across to turning ch, 2 dc in top of turning ch - 9 dc at end of row

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in each st across to turning ch, 3 dc in top of turning ch - 13 dc at end of row

**Rows 5-16:** Rep rows 3 and 4 six times - 49 dc at end of row

**Last Row (Hooding Edge):** Work row 2 of textured st. Fasten off.

### Finishing

With RS facing, pin hood over one corner of blanket, matching edges.

### Edging

1. Join yarn with sl st in any corner blanket
2. Work row 2 of textured st evenly spaced around entire outside edge of blanket, working through both thicknesses when working hood corner and working (sc, 2 dc) in each corner of blanket; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.
3. Weave in Ends
