



## Curled Cloth Ribbon

### Supplies:

- Your choice of fabric ribbon
- Any size of dowel, depending on desired finished size
- Wooden clothes pins or a stapler that opens to shoot into a flat surface
- A cookie sheet or aluminum foil

### Directions

1. Cut your dowels to fit in your cookie sheet if you are using one, or the size of your oven if you are using aluminum foil
2. Preheat your oven to 275° F
3. Wrap the ribbon on the dowel in a spiral pattern so that the sides touch or nearly touch (the tighter the spiral is, the tighter the curl will be) and secure with the wooden clothes pins or by stapling the ribbon to the dowel at each end
4. Bake for 25 minutes in cookie sheet or on foil
5. Remove from the oven and allow to cool completely before uncoiling the ribbon from the dowel

**Note:** Be sure to store the curled ribbon carefully! It can be easily crushed
