Halloween DecoMesh Wreaths

Supplies:

- 1 or 2 DecoMesh colors your choice (one roll makes one wreath)
- Work wreath
- Scissors
- Floral witch

Optional: Witch hat, witch legs, spiders, spider webs, lights, glitter mesh ribbon

Directions:

- Gather the end of the decomesh together in your hand, and starting on the inside ring of the work wreath twist two pieces of pine around the end to secure it. If you are using two colors, use both at the same time
- 2. Measure out about 12 inches of decomesh by gathering it together. Pinch the mesh together in your hand at the 12 inch mark, the squash it so it poufs. Where you have it pinched, twist the next pieces of pine around the mesh to secure it. Fan out the loops as you go around to create a pouf. If your poufs are too big or too small, adjust them as needed. If you are using two colors, separate the colors & fan them
- 3. Continue around the wreath on the same pattern until both rings are filled and all the pieces of pine have been used. Cut off an leftover mesh
- 4. Optional: Add on your Witch hat, witch legs, spiders, spider webs, lights, glitter mesh ribbon etc. Secure onto the wreath by wiring on with floral wire and twisting tight



Halloween DecoMesh Wreaths

Supplies:

- 1 or 2 DecoMesh colors your choice (one roll makes one wreath)
- Work wreath
- Scissors
- Floral witch

Optional: Witch hat, witch legs, spiders, spider webs, lights, glitter mesh ribbon

Directions:

- Gather the end of the decomesh together in your hand, and starting on the inside ring of the work wreath twist two pieces of pine around the end to secure it. If you are using two colors, use both at the same time
- 2. Measure out about 12 inches of decomesh by gathering it together. Pinch the mesh together in your hand at the 12 inch mark, the squash it so it poufs. Where you have it pinched, twist the next pieces of pine around the mesh to secure it. Fan out the loops as you go around to create a pouf. If your poufs are too big or too small, adjust them as needed. If you are using two colors, separate the colors & fan them
- 3. Continue around the wreath on the same pattern until both rings are filled and all the pieces of pine have been used. Cut off an leftover mesh
- 4. Optional: Add on your Witch hat, witch legs, spiders, spider webs, lights, glitter mesh ribbon etc. Secure onto the wreath by wiring on with floral wire and twisting tight
