



Reverse Canvas Wall Pockets

Supplies

- Stretched Canvas (new or used)
- Burlap or other fabric
- Hot Glue
- Hanging Hardware
- Rubber date stamp (optional)
- Embellishments (optional)

Directions

1. Rummage through your old practice paintings or the picture bin at the thrift store and snag some used canvases to up-cycle
2. Rubber stamp the canvas frome to add vintage character
3. Trim out a hemmed or seamed section of burlap to cover the bottom half of the back side (now the front side) of the canvas, allowing enough extra material to fold over the side and bottom to the back
4. Make the hemmed edge the top of the pocket and hot glue the burlap to the canvas along the sides and back
5. Add hanging hardware to the back
6. Leave your wall pockets plain or embellish
7. Tie up the pockets with baker's twine to hold little extras
8. Hang and fill
