



Wood Fillet Frames

Supplies:

- Unfinished Wood Frame with Fillet Moulding
- Patterned Paper
- Rocks, Moss, Twine, Cork
- Burlap Strips
- Glüber Glue Dot for creating flowers
- Metal Embellishment
- E6000 Glue
- Acrylic Stain & Foam Paint Brush

Directions:

1. Stain the frame. Let dry
2. Work in sections around the edge of the frame applying the E6000 Glue and setting the moss, rocks, twine and cork
3. Follow the directions on the packaging for the Glüber Glue Dot to create the burlap flower. Glue the flower onto the frame
4. Cut the patterned paper to fit the photo slot in the frame and glue it to the backing of the photo frame insert
5. Using the E6000 glue to glue on the metal embellishments in the middle of the frame
6. Enjoy your creation

Alternate Decorating Idea:

Paint the frame desired color
Glue patterned paper around the outside of the frame
Add vinyl words, sticker, etc to the center part of the frame



Wood Fillet Frames

Supplies:

- Unfinished Wood Frame with Fillet Moulding
- Patterned Paper

Directions:

1. Stain the frame. Let dry

4. Cut the patterned paper to fit the photo slot in the frame and glue it to the backing of the photo frame insert
5. Using the E6000 glue to glue on the metal embellishments in the middle of the frame
6. Enjoy your creation

Alternate Decorating Idea:

Paint the frame desired color
Glue patterned paper around the outside of the frame
Add vinyl words, sticker, etc to the center part of the frame
