



Travel Tic Tac Toe

Supplies:

- One Metal Tin
- Coordinating Scrapbook Paper
- Tic Tac Toe Vinyl
- 10 - 1/2" Buttons
- 10 - Heavy Duty Magnets
- Mod Podge
- Foam Brush
- Scissors
- E-6000 Glue

Directions:

(Tip: E-6000 is a strong adhesive. Before you begin, be sure you are in a well-ventilated area.)

1. Measure and cut two 1" strips of scrapbook paper to fit around the bottom of the box with a slight overlap.
2. Cut a piece of scrapbook paper approximately 5 1/4" x 3 1/4" to fit the lid of the box. (Round the corners)
3. Mod Podge the papers in place. Allow time to dry.
4. Seal coat with a layer of Mod Podge. Allow it to dry again.
5. Adhere the buttons to the magnets with E-6000 glue.
6. Apply the vinyl to the lid of the box.
7. Place some paper and a pencil in your box so that you can keep score along with an extra playing piece.
8. Have fun!
